#### Women's Football

- Develop a specialized youth programme for women
- A female competition for schools
- Enhancement of Women's League
- Host Invitational Women's Soccer festival

### Competition

- Upgrade of domestic leagues and progressively expand
  Premiership over next four years
- Year round football
- Two transfer window periods (special dispensation will apply)
- New formats to market
  - a) interactive marketing & promotion
  - b) domestic broadcast rights
  - c) enhance Club & national sponsorship
- Semi-professional League

#### **Pursuit of Excellence**

- National Technical Director to oversee development programmes for players and coaches, to work alongside coaches and play a major part in selection of all national squads; providing technical advice and input in all areas of football
- National Skills Test for 7-12 year old players, computerized test available to all, to create a data base of all our youth players and monitor development
- Barbados as a Centre of Excellence recognised in the Caribbean (CFU, CONCACAF)

### Football development

- Restructuring the BFA
- Club Development to establish constitutions and management structures for clubs, computerized player registration process, licensing procedure
- Football Development Unit
- Resource of additional funds
- Steps towards a semi-professionalism with high-quality leadership and financial stability

#### **Facilities**

- new dedicated football pitches with floodlights
- Upgrade of National Stadium
- Unveiling of two FIFA sized pitches in Wildey
- Unveiling of new home for football and the football family in Wildey with office, training facility and conference room
- New dedicated football venue (to be announced)

### **Coach education**

- Good coaches mean good football
- Host more coaching clinics locally
- Assessment programmes by FIFA Instructors
- To have at least two professional—licensed Barbadian coaches

### Referee development

- Increase in women referees
- Provide trained instructors and assessors at all levels
- Establishment of a Referee secretariat with full time employee
- To have at least one recognised FIFA International referee at Olympic and World Cup level and three International assistant referees

#### Schools football

- Better working relationship with NSC and BSSFL
- Football oriented camps with skilled instructors
- Feeder programme for children to merge with senior clubs
- Enhancement of the School's football competition

### Inclusive initiatives

- Development of programmes for the disabled
- Making venues friendlier to the disabled
- Incorporation of 'disability' component into coaching programmes
- Hosting of a disability exhibition game and tournament

#### **Futsal & Beach Soccer**

- Greater emphasis on organising the sport
- Greater investment in Futsal & Beach Soccer
- Futsal & Beach Soccer tournaments local, regional and international
- Courses on rules and regulations of the game
- Pathway for scholarships and entry to international contracts
